FEES, BURSARIES & LOANS

All courses at CONEL and most at WestKing and CANDI up to Level 2, are FREE* to adults aged 19 or over.

If you are aged 19-23 and studying your first Level 3 course it may also be **FREE***.

If you choose an apprenticeship, the employer pays your tuition fees.

If your course is not free, you can pay in instalments or apply for a student loan. For more information visit: gov.uk/advanced-learner-loan

You do not have to pay back your tuition fees for an Access course if you go on to study a related higher education course.

Fees for higher education courses are considerably less than university study and can be paid for in instalments or wit a loan. You only start o repay your loan once you are earning £25,725 (subject to change). For more information visit: gov.uk/government/organisations/student-loans-company

Bursaries of up to £1,200 a year are available for students receiving certain benefits or from low-income households


